I am very excited about the upcoming short course season and eager to see how much further this team can grow and improve. Obviously it will be hard to duplicate the same kind of success we had last year, but I feel that nothing is unachievable. I know that the short course season is very long and a lot of people sometimes get lost throughout the year, so I have decided to breakdown the season into four parts. For this newsletter I will talk about the time period from Labor Day until our first invitational meet in Springfield from October 10-12. During this time there will be a lot of time for stroke work and technical improvement with each swimmer. The important thing to know is that each individual's improvement is dependent upon their own willingness to learn. The swimmers have to make the effort to change things with their stroke and be willing to take a step back to take two or three steps forward. So please take advantage of this time and know that I am more motivated than ever to make sure that everyone has a successful year. So enjoy the next couple of weeks!

### *Dues Increase this Fall*

The board has approved an increase in dues for the 2003-2004 season. We want to emphasize that this increase will bring us BACK to the levels we paid for the 2000-2001 season. Those of you who have been with the club that long may remember that the fees were reduced in the 2001-2002 season as an incentive to convert to the quarterly payment method.

The need to increase dues is based on across the board increases in expenses that have been experienced over the past few years. These increases were offset in the past by the additional revenue that was received by a growing membership. However, membership growth this past year leveled off, partly due to a membership cap which was implemented this past fall.

The quarterly fees will be as follows: Minnows and Dolphins - \$150; Piranhas - \$175; Tigersharks - \$200; Seniors - \$225. Deduct \$15 for the 2<sup>nd</sup> and each additional swimmer in the family. Please note that the annual USA Swimming fee has also increased to \$45 for 2004.

## CSC Records Overhaul

You may have noticed some changes to the CSC long and short course records as posted on the internet recently. The events tracked have been standardized and dusty record books searched for missing times and errors. Basically, the events that will be tracked going forward are only those that are listed in the USA Swimming motivational times standards for each age group. In addition, any CSC record must be at least an "A" time, except for the 8 & Under records which must be "BB" or better. The 8 & Under records will only be tracked in short course and will include the 25 yard events. In the future, relays will be added to the record books as well!
